FONLOS ENGAGIERT SICH FÜR BERLINER KUNST & KULTUR

Das Urban Art Festival *Berlin Unlimited* nutzt Tablets von fonlos®

Vom 03. bis zum 10. Oktober 2014 findet in Berlin das Berlin Unlimited statt. Das urbane, transdisziplinäre Festival wird diverse Workshops, Film-Vorführungen, Lesungen, Ausstellungen, Parties, Performances und Führungen umfassen, die allesamt zum Ziel haben, ein zeitgenössisches Bild eines Berlins zu zeichnen, das nunmehr 25 Jahre nach dem Fall der Mauer vielzählige Entwicklungen durchgemacht hat – in der Kunst, in der Architektur, aber auch in den Köpfen der Menschen. Ein kleinen Beitrag dazu kann auch fonlos leisten - und stellt der Veranstaltung mehrere Tablets zur Verfügung.

Doch was ist das Berlin Unlimited genau? Hierzu ein kleiner Auszug aus dem Programm: "WHY UNLIMITED? As nowhere else in the world, the limits of Berlin have been changing and evolving, transforming the urban fabric as the way the city is used, lived and comprehended. Nowadays, Berlin is perceived as the international capital of freedom. Is that reputation of myth? What can we learn from Berlin? – To define whether Berlin is Limited or Unlimited the notion of limits will be fragmented. We will question what constitutes a limit. With Unlimited guests, we will explore Walls, Grounds, Times, Powers, Money, Bodies and Distances. Those fragments of limits will be decomposed, dissected, articulated, experimented, confronted and brought back together to establish a contemporary picture of Berlin. That necessary inventory is meant to be used as a source of inspiration from within the city and beyond."

Gerne stellen wir den Verantwortlichen und Koordinatoren des Berlin Unlimited einige Tablets zur Verfügung, mit denen die ganztägigen Veranstaltungen realisiert und durchgeführt werden. Zu der Zielgruppe von fonlos zählen neben Software-Unternehmen und IT-Spezialisten auch vollkommen branchenferne Unternehmen wie Film-/TV-/Werbeproduktionen und eben auch Kulturprojekte. „Gerne unterstützen wir Kunst- & Kultur-Projekte wie diese. Daran sieht man, dass Smartphones und Tablets heute in verschiedensten Bereichen ein Rolle spielen.“, so Pierre Lässig, Gründer von fonlos.

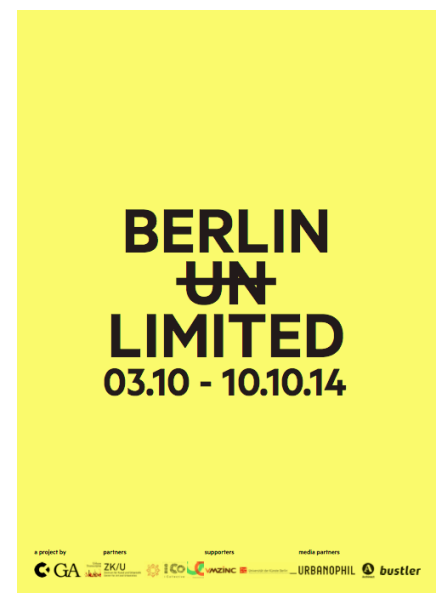

Berlin Unlimited is the first transdisciplinary festival gathering arts, architecture and urban discourses to establish a picture of the contemporary Berlin 25 years after the fall of the wall. The 7 days festival settles in the Zentrum für Kunst und Urbanistik (ZK/U) in October 2014. A diversified and thrilling programme of workshops, exhibitions, lectures, conferences, film screenings, creative caterings, performances, guided tours and urban parties will take place with numbered artists and special guests, inviting all Berlin enthusiasts to discover a complete narrative of the city based on the contemporary artistic production in context.
